# From the Headteacher

**Dear Parents and Carers,**

**Welcome to the end of what has been another busy week here at Slade!**

Once again I want to begin by expressing my extreme gratitude to all in the school community for your ongoing support as we continue with our endeavours to keep everyone safe and well. A special mention to all the pupils, staff and parents in the second class bubble closed this week for responding and adapting so quickly to life in the virtual world. We hope that you and your loved ones all continue to remain safe and well during your period of self-isolation and we look forward to welcoming you back into school very soon.

As you are aware, yesterday saw the Government announce that Kent and Medway will move into tier three when the national lockdown ends next Wednesday. At the time of writing we are still awaiting the publication of specific tier 3 education guidance. However, we have been informed by the Department for Education that these updates will include the latest advice for clinically extremely vulnerable children, young people and staff, advice on the use of face coverings in education settings, educational trips, performances, and the provision of wraparound care. I will as always update you on this guidance and the impact it will have for us as a school, if any, as and when I receive it. Our annual Christmas newsletter and update is all prepared and ready to drop into your inbox. However, we are delaying sharing it with you today whilst still awaiting further tier 3 guidance for schools; in doing so we can then be confident that the information we share is compliant with the newest of guidance and thus avoid having to make any changes. I can confirm however that in order to minimize the risk of any possible transmission of the virus between homes and school we will not be facilitating the delivery of Christmas cards this year. Instead, we are encouraging children to either send a virtual card to their class via the class email address or alternatively to send one card to the class which can then be quarantined before being shared and displayed in the classroom. Thank you for your cooperation and understanding with this decision.

There was much excitement from the adults in school yesterday following the delivery of the long overdue and eagerly anticipated welly racks! These have been purchased to enable the safe and tidy storage of your child's wellington boots in school; these will be positioned around the school and set up for use during the coming week. Please can I encourage you to send a pair of boots into school for your child if you have not already done so. Thank you.

Finally, just to let you know that Miss Garrett will be based in Watlingbury School during the coming week but is still contactable if necessary via our school office.

# This Week at Slade

## NHS Flu Vaccinations

**We were delighted to have the Kent Community Health team with us yesterday as they carried out the annual influenza sprayed vaccination, available to all yeargroups at the school for the first time. We had 300 children who were given consent, this is 71% of the school which is an excellent take up. Well done to all of the children who received the spray yesterday, you should have gone home with your Fluenz Tetra Nasal Spray Suspension Information leaflet for reference.**

We are pleased to confirm that the team will be back to carry out the vaccinations to the groups of children presently on a 14 day self isolation period. We will let everyone in these groups know when this date has been finalised.

If you consented to have your child immunised this week, but they were absent for any other reason than the 14 day self isolation, you can still receive the vaccination by contacting the KCH immunisation team and booking a place on one of their remaining clinics. Please telephone them on 0300 123 5205, or email over the weekend via [kchft.cyp-immunisationteam@nhs.net](mailto:kchft.cyp-immunisationteam@nhs.net). If you are enquiring via email, please leave your child's name, date of birth, school, vaccination required and a contact telephone number.
