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Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome to the last newsletter of this term!

This final week has been another busy one with egg-citing learning happening across the school. We've had cookery and baking, with Year 3 creating (and eating!) their own pizzas and Reception children baking (and eating!) their chocolate Easter egg baskets. There's been plenty of needlework too with Year 2 classes sewing the puppets that they've designed during the term and Year 5 children creating their own soft toys. Not forgetting all of the inter class sports tournaments that have taken place across the week too! Phew; well done everyone!

As many of you are aware, on Tuesday 29 March, the government set out the <u>next steps for living with COVID-19</u> in England from Friday 1 April. In addition, schools have now received updated guidance from the DfE outlining the changes to measures and guidance for managing COVID-19 in education and childcare settings from today. Therefore, children who are unwell and have a high temperature should stay at home and avoid contact with other people. They can come back to school, when they no longer have a high temperature, and they are well enough to attend. The guidance continues that regular asymptomatic testing is no longer required; however, free COVID-19 tests will continue to be available for specific groups, including eligible patients and NHS staff, once the universal testing offer ends on Friday 1 April. Should you have any further queries please refer to the guidance at the link above. We will also be sending a reminder of procedures to follow if your child is unwell at the start of Term 5.

At the time of writing I am very much looking forward to attending the egg-cellent Easter Egg Hunt which the fabulous PTA volunteers are hosting on the school field after school later today. Many thanks to all the parents who have worked tirelessly behind the scenes to arrange this event for all of our families to enjoy. Many thanks too to the many of you who have bought tickets to attend; all funds raised enable us to afford those additional extras that otherwise we wouldn't be able to afford for every child at Slade to benefit from. So many thanks from us all. I look forward to seeing you on the field later! (A reminder please to use the back gate in Hawden Road if attending; thank you.)

A huge thank you to all parents across the school for your co-operation and understanding as this week we welcomed yet more parents onto the school site at the end of the day to collect their children. Thank you all for enabling the transition to these changes to go as smoothly as they did; we very much appreciate it. An overview of the arrangements for all year groups will be shared at the start of Term 5 as a reminder to all following the Easter break.

Over a school year, we are due to be open for 190 days which equates to 380 sessions with registration in the morning at 08:50 and after lunch in the afternoon.

It is important that the children are at school on time every day to prevent disruption and upset to their day and for the rest of their class.
