


Threadworm

We are aware that there have been a couple of cases of Threadworm in school recently.

Threadworms (pinworms) are tiny worms in faeces. They're common in children and spread easily. You can treat them without seeing a GP.

The NHS website has lots of information on the condition which will help if your child is showing symptoms of Threadworm or you are concerned in anyway.

The NHS guidance on Threadworm is that children do not need to be off of school or nursery.

Our Changing Times (Tables)

We are to have launched changes to the teaching and learning of times tables at Slade.

Our Maths Leader, James Duffin, is pleased to explain:

'We have put together a guide for helping your children learn times tables at home; and a short video presentation that goes into more detail behind the logic to the new approach and how it will be administered.



The National Curriculum states that children are expected to have recall of their multiplication and division facts up to the 12 times table by the end of Year 4. We have put in a more structured system in place to help children learn these facts. Each year group from Year 2 to Year 4 will have a times table to learn each term. This is set out in the table sent home via Arbor email on Thursday.

This approach will allow teachers to make greater connections between the different times tables and will hopefully ensure that children have embedded their learning and have instant recall of these facts. It also allows for the revisiting of times tables at different points.

In addition to his, children in Year 1 will learn how to count in 2s, 5s and 10s. Children in Year 5 and 6 will continue to learn their times tables, as they supplement much of their maths learning in Upper Key Stage 2.

This term we will be looking at making changes to the way we use Times Tables Rock Stars as a resource in school. If you have misplaced your child's log in details, please get in contact with the class teacher via the class email address who will be able to provide them for you.'


Out and About



Natural History Wildlife Photography Exhibition

This week, classes from across Year 2 and all of KS2 have been visiting the Old Big School Tunnel Gallery at Tonbridge School this week to see The Natural History Museum's Wildlife Photographer of the Year Exhibition.

This exhibition has been showcasing the world's best nature photography and photojournalism for more than 50 years, with this exhibition being the 57th edition.



Miss Taylor has organised the series of trips to the exhibition; celebrating the power of photography and the wonders of the natural world which explores a planet under pressure. This spectacular show comprises of 100 winning photographs and an accompanying video.

Attracting over two million visitors annually worldwide, Wildlife Photographer of the Year is renowned not only for its compelling imagery but also for the quality of its interpretation. The exhibition sparks a global conversation about sustainability and the conservation of wildlife - it challenges and encourages people around the world to consider their responsibility to protect our planet's breath-taking biodiversity.

We are thrilled that our children have been able to take part in this conversation, which we hope they may have continued at home. Our thanks to the gallery staff at Tonbridge and to the parents who were able to walk the children to the venue which made the visits possible.












