

Slade Primary School Pupil Premium Promise 23/24



The school receives Pupil Premium funding for pupils who:

- <u>qualify for free school meals</u> or have done so at any time in the past six years due to parent/s being in receipt of the following benefits (*Income Support, income-based Jobseeker's Allowance, income-related Employment and Support Allowance, support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999, the guaranteed element of Pension Credit, Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190), Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit, Universal Credit if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)*
- have a parent serving in the <u>armed forces</u>
- are looked after children or pupils who have been adopted from care

If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium Funding, we promise to provide the following:

- ✓ A place at Breakfast Club
- ✓ Support towards School Uniform
- ✓ Support towards a PE Kit
- ✓ A place at one extra-curricular club or activity (subject to availability)
- ✓ Support for curriculum trips
- \checkmark Bursary or financial support for School Journey (Year 6 only)
