## FROM THE HEADTEACHER

Dear Parents and Carers,

Happy New Year everyone and welcome back to Term 3. I hope that you all had an enjoyable, restful Christmas break and were able to spend time with family and friends.

It has been a busy first full week back with lots of learning taking place both indoors and out in spite of the wet, cold and sometimes snowy conditions! It really has been lovely to see all the children settling back into school, catching up with friends and sharing their news at the start of their learning journeys for this term. A special mention and well done to the children and staff who have this week modelled our ‘resilience’ value, braving the weather when down in Forest School! I hear that everyone enjoyed the opportunity to experience our fire pit when needing to take the edge off the chill! Well done and thank you everyone for a great start to Term 3.

Do check out the year group newsletters that were sent out on Monday to find out more of what your child will be learning across the coming weeks. As always, please don’t hesitate to contact your child’s class teacher via their class email address should you have any queries or concerns about your child in school. However, a reminder that these inboxes are only monitored at the beginning and end of the school day following which a response will be sent out within 48 hours. Therefore, any information for class teachers to be aware of during the school day should be sent by calling the school office, following which the message will be shared with your child’s teacher.

On Wednesday we held our third and final Open Morning for prospective parents currently looking to choose a school for children who are due to start in September 2024. The morning was an opportunity for our visitors to hear once again about the provision on offer here at Slade followed by time to explore and see a typical Wednesday morning in action! As you would expect, our visitors were once again full of praise for all that they saw and were especially complimentary about our fabulous children! Well done to everyone involved, including our PTA team for providing the refreshments. A reminder that the closing date to apply for a Reception school place is this coming Monday, 15<sup>th</sup> January, using the online application form on the KCC admissions website.

At the start of this new year a reminder please of our expectations with regard to school uniform; all of our children are expected to wear regulation school uniform to school every day; a list of all permitted school uniform items can be found on our school website. In addition, a reminder that all items of clothing worn to school should be named in order that we can return any uniform that becomes misplaced to their rightful owner. Our lost property boxes are already full of unnamed items that haven’t been claimed so the boxes will be now be placed outside at Friday pick-ups for you to take a look to try to retrieve your child’s missing uniform. Moving forward, any unclaimed and unnamed items each week will now be donated to the PTA pre-loved uniform store for re-sale.

Having experienced snow flurries earlier this week, a reminder that following heavy snowfall any decisions around whether to open or close the school will always be made on the basis of the safety and welfare of all pupils and staff. This includes a daily risk assessment of the school building and grounds whilst ensuring that there are enough staff able to travel into school to enable us to operate safely. A text will be sent to all parents as early as possible once this decision to open or close the school has been made in addition to being communicated through all of our social media channels too, including the KCC school closures website <https://www.kentclosures.co.uk/>

Finally, for those of you planning ahead, term dates for the next academic year 2024-2025 will be available on the school website at the start of next week.

It's important to find out more about the schools you are interested in before you decide to name them on the application form.

You can name up to three Primary schools, inside or outside of Kent, but you must name them all on the same application.

Moving house during the application window will likely complicate your application and we therefore advise you to pay special attention to key dates in the admissions process. KCC has no discretionary authority to vary the process for parents who cannot complete address moves in time to make use of them for admissions purposes. If you have queries relating to this, please email the team on one of the email addresses below.

**Key dates**

<b>Friday 3 November 2023</b>	Online application process opens. Go to <a href="https://kent.gov.uk/primaryadmissions">kent.gov.uk/primaryadmissions</a> to register and apply.
<b>Monday 15 January 2024</b>	Online application process closes for the main round. Any amendments after this date must be emailed to <a href="mailto:kentinfoadmissions@kent.gov.uk">kentinfoadmissions@kent.gov.uk</a> .
<b>Tuesday 16 April 2024</b>	Offers of school places sent to parents via email after 4pm.
<b>Tuesday 30 April 2024</b>	Parents should contact the school to accept/refuse the place that has been offered and can use the link in the offer email to ask for their child to be added to the waiting list of schools named on the original application.
<b>Tuesday 14 May 2024</b>	Appeals need to be lodged by this date to be heard before September – appeals information can be found in <a href="https://kent.gov.uk/schooladmissions">kent.gov.uk/schooladmissions</a> . You can only appeal for schools that were named on the application form.

## Primary School Applications: Deadline Looms

Parents and carers of children born between 1 September 2019 and 31 August 2020 will no doubt be aware that the deadline for making applications for their children to start their Primary School journey is fast approaching.

**The online application portal from Kent County Council closes at 23:59 on Monday 15 January (just after this weekend).**

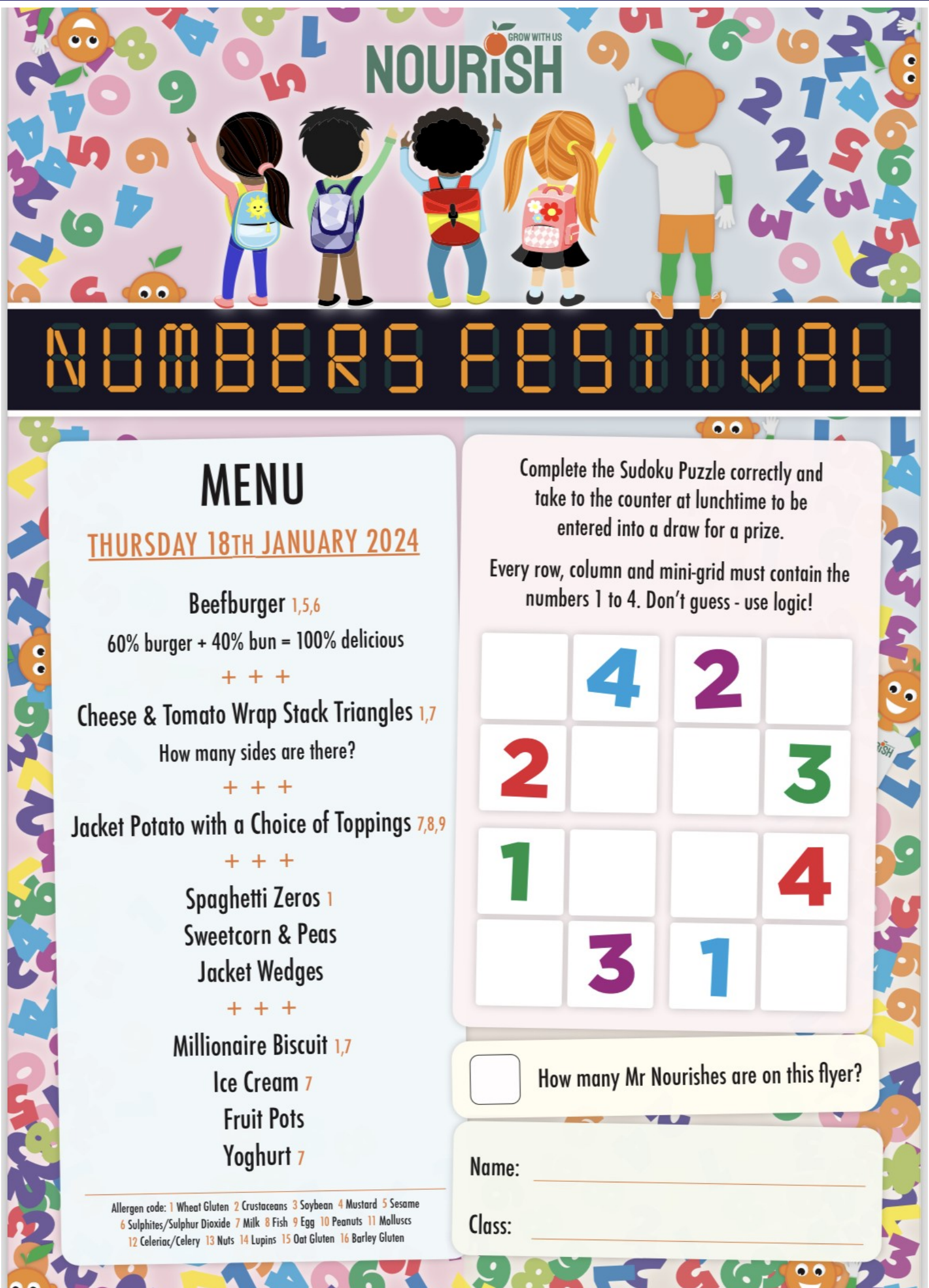
# Numbers Festival Lunch and Competition

### New Intercom System

One thing both parents and the Yeti's team have asked us for is for a secure intercom system for families to use when dropping off or collecting from Breakfast or After School Clubs.

I am delighted therefore to say that we have installed such a system, which will mean a speedier and safer service from the team and less waiting around in the cold or in the corridor for the children. You can find the intercom at the foot of the stairs in a position that can successfully be used by wheelchair users as well as those standing.

## Looking Ahead: Bag2School on Tuesday 30 January

On Tuesday 30 January we have arranged a collection with Bag2School to start our fundraising off for 2024....we bring in our good quality, unwanted items, and they will pay us based on the total weight.

Bag2School is a free eco-friendly fundraising scheme that helps schools and charities raise funds through textile recycling. Their aim is to promote the reuse of clothes and shoes to benefit those who rely on second hand clothes. For every 1kg we collect, they will pay us 50p. All money raised through this scheme will go straight back to the school for additional resources for all our children.

Below is a list of what we can, and cannot, collect. All items should be in good, reusable condition.

### What we can collect:

### What we cannot collect:

- Duvets and blankets
- Pillow and cushions
- Carpets, rugs and mats
- Soiled, painted, ripped or wet clothes
- School uniform with and without logos
- Corporate clothing and workwear
- Textile off cuts, yarns or threaded material
- Furniture and large items
- Batteries

Wet items cannot be collected, so we will be keeping an eye on the weather when we decide the collection point!

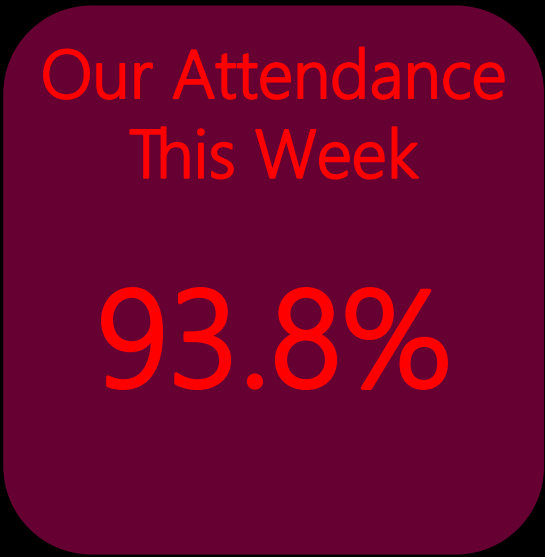

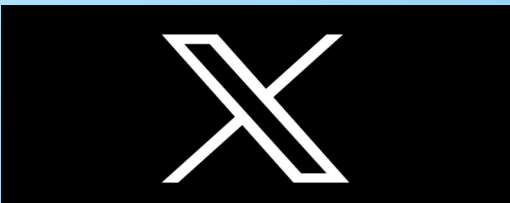



### School Dinners

School Dinners provided by Nourish Contract Catering are free to the following groups:  
EYFS Classes, Year 1 Classes, Year 2 Classes, EYFS, KS1 AND KS2 pupils eligible for benefits related Free School Meals

School Dinners provided to KS2 (Year 3-6) children are charged at £2.40 per meal.  
Credit should be loaded onto the Meals section of your Arbor account.

### Yeti’s Wraparound Provision (Breakfast and After School Clubs)

Breakfast Club is charged at £4.20 per session

After School Club is charged at different pricepoints:

Until 16:30: £4.20 // Until 17:30: £8.60

If your child participates in an after school activity, please let us know via [yetis@slade.kent.sch.uk](mailto:yetis@slade.kent.sch.uk) and we charge only for the 16:30 - 17:30 time at £ 4.40.
