## FROM THE HEADTEACHER

Dear Parents and Carers,

Our Year 6 pupils have all been having a fabulous time, in the gorgeous woodland, on their School Journey to Carrot Wood this week! All the children have been making the most of the facilities and enjoying a wide range of activities, ranging from abseiling to mountain biking to kayaking to swimming... to name but a few of their experiences from the week. Do check out our X feed which captures the fabulous fun they have had! I was invited to join in for the day on Tuesday, and had a fabulous time tackling 'The Great Escape'; I've never seen so much mud! We look forward to welcoming everyone home today and hearing about the memories that have been made! My huge thanks to the fantastic team of staff who have spent time away from their own families (and beds!) this week to enable this trip to happen for the children; we very much appreciate it and wish you all a restful, mud-free weekend!

Looking ahead to next week, a print friendly version of your child's end of year report will be emailed out to you on Monday. The report will provide an overview of your child's attainment and progress during this academic year whilst recording some of their personal highlights too. A separate letter providing further information regarding the content of the report will also be emailed out to you. In addition, children in Year 6 will receive their end of Key Stage SATs results and Year 1 parents will receive their child's phonics screening results too. Furthermore, parents of children in Reception will receive an overview of their child's end of EYFS results with children in Year 4 receiving the results from their Multiplication Check taken earlier this year. Explanations regarding the statutory data that you receive will be sent out along with the reports but if you have any queries regarding any of these results or your child's report in general then please don't hesitate to contact your child's class teacher via the class email address. As we approach the summer break, a reminder that there is no expectation from any staff here at Slade that any of our families should be buying end of term gifts for members of the team. Additionally, no parent should ever feel pressured into contributing to any arranged collections for gifts organised by classes or other groups in school. Thank you to everyone for respecting each families' personal choices with regards to gifting at this time of year. It is worth remembering too that nothing means more to those of us working here in school than receiving a homemade card and a heartfelt spoken thank you at the end of the year!

As you will remember, earlier this year Louise Taylor stepped down from her Teaching Assistant position in Gruffalo Class to enable her to focus on her personal journey of healing following the enormous loss and trauma that she has suffered following the death of her son Tom, an ex-pupil here at Slade. Over the months since Tom's passing we have been sharing ideas as to how as a school community we would like to pay tribute to Tom and celebrate his wonderful life. In addition, we have been considering possible fundraising opportunities to raise both awareness of and funds for 'Victim Support', an independent charity dedicated to supporting victims of crime and traumatic incidents, which has been there for Louise and her family following their loss of Tom. Therefore, we have decided to enter a staff team of runners into the Tonbridge Half Marathon in September and are hoping that the school community will support us and sponsor us in the coming months as we look to celebrate Tom's life whilst also raising funds for this very worthy cause. Further details of how you can support us will be shared in the new term but I wanted to provide you with plenty of notice should anyone else wish to dust off their running shoes over the summer and get signed up to run as part of Team Slade! Watch this space for updates on how our training is going too! Thank you everyone in anticipation of your support with this fundraising event.

### Reminder: No Activity Clubs Next Week

There are no Pre, During or After School Activity Clubs next week as stated on the activity list timetable. This is due to next week being the last of the school year.

Please make sure you have arranged collection or other provision for all children who would normally be at an activity club after school.

Yeti's Wraparound remains open of course, but must be booked in advance as sessions do get full. Where spaces remain, booking is available up to 2 hours before Yeti's opens, so can be done from anywhere via your Arbor account.



### Booking Activities for 2024/25

Where one door closes, another opens and we are already fully set up for September with the list of pre, during and after school activity clubs for Term 1 advertised to all parents of children who will be at Slade in September via an email sent yesterday. This list is also posted on our website, here: [Extra Curricular Clubs](#).

Please remember that to attend independently run clubs, you must book and pay directly with the organiser and for school run activities, you must book via your Arbor account. This includes the choir groups that take place at lunchtimes.

The choir will have a strict limit next year, and only those registered via Arbor will be able to take part in the various trips and concerts associated with membership.

**The booking window for securing spaces on school run activities opens at 20:00 on Monday 15 July.**



### Yeti's 2024/25: Important Information

The team in Yeti's are already looking forward to greeting users of our wraparound provision in September at the start of a new school year.

Typically ahead of the game, Yeti's are accepting bookings for September very soon. The booking window for Term 1 will open at 20:00 on Tuesday 16 July. This is 24 hours behind the activity clubs to allow for easier planning and less requirement for cancellations of booked slots at Yeti's that will be no longer needed due to participation at activities elsewhere.

### Nourish Prices from September

School Business Manager, Jill Westwood, has been negotiating a deal for paid school meals from September.

The price for a school meal from 1 September will be £2.55/meal.

Nourish have had to raise prices due to cost pressures, one which is passed directly to the customer (in this case, the school). We are pleased to say that the increase has been kept to the minimum and remains lower than most comparable schools locally.

School meals from Nourish are free to all children in receipt of benefits related Free School Meals and/or are in EYFS or Key Stage 1 classes.

School meals from Nourish are charged each day to all other Key Stage 2 pupils (those in Year 3-6).

Meals should be paid for in advance by topping up the Meals section of your Arbor account.

Parents of children in Year 2 should be aware that they are now moving out of Key Stage 1 and that meals will be chargeable as above from the first day back at school in September.

Regrettably, the PTA were left with no choice but to cancel tonight's planned Pimm's and Silent Disco event.

This is due to the wetter weather we have experienced today, which was forecast earlier in the week when a decision on the event had to be made.

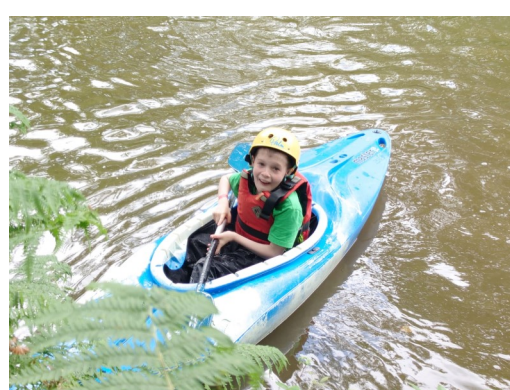
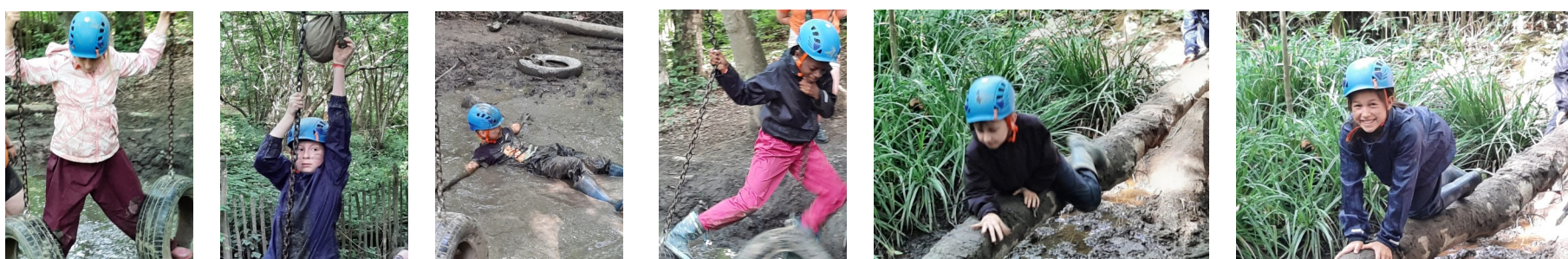


### It Continued All Week!

What a fantastic week it has been at Carrotty Wood as the pupils from Dragon and Griffin Classes enjoyed their full-on action packed Activity Week.

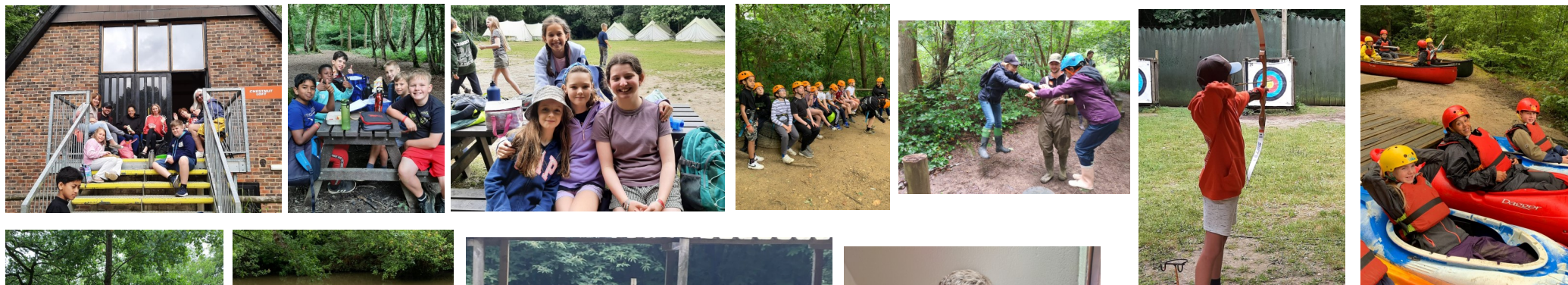

Last Thursday they went up to Sidcup Cricket Club to play the county finals against 11 other regional finalists from places such as Dartford, Medway, Folkestone, Ashford, Canterbury and Thanet.

The Slade team remained unbeaten in every match they played to beating Bridge and Patricbourne to win the competition.

Everyone played their part with brilliant batting, bowling and fielding from the team – Arya even got a wicket with her first bowl!

This was the precursor to more success yesterday, this time at the prestigious surroundings of Ashford Prep School as our Year 2 Cricket team also became Kent champions! The team won all but one of their matches, surviving a scare when they lost a match by just two runs, before finishing off the job in style.

Greta in Gnome Class summed up the emotion of the Year 2 team at the end of the tournament, 'I felt so excited throughout the whole day - after we got through the local rounds we knew we could play cricket well as a team, but when the teams were read out at the end in the order and we were not called out as being in second place - we knew we had scored the most runs throughout the whole day and we had come first. We let out a massive cheer, it was brilliant!'

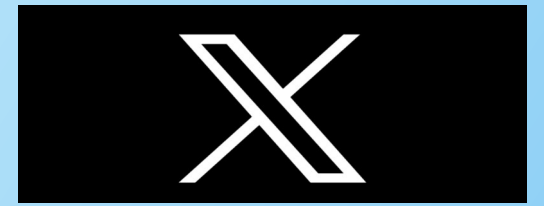
