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Dear Parents and Carers

Happy New Year everyone and welcome back to Term 3. I hope that you all had an enjoyable, restful Christmas break and enjoyed time spent with family and friends. A special welcome to our new children and their families who have joined us over the break; we hope that you soon feel part of our Slade family.

Welcome too to new members of staff who have joined us this term. Helen Lipman has quickly settled into her new role of Sphinx Class Teacher, joining us from Fleetdown Primary School in Dartford. We look forward to getting to know Helen as she settles into school life here. Also this week, we welcome Yashada Satbhai to our expanding support staff team. Yashada is providing one to one support for two of our pupils in school, following her relocation to Tonbridge. A warm welcome to each of you; we hope that you soon feel at home here as part of the Slade family.

On Wednesday this week, we welcomed Tel German our Local Authority School Improvement Adviser to the school for the first of her visits this academic year. Tel visited each of the classrooms observing lessons, talking to the children about their learning and looking in books before spending time with myself, Miss Garrett and Simon Griffiths, Chair of Governors. She was impressed by the 'exemplary' and 'strong' provision that she saw and the positive changes that have been made since her previous visit to the school in June. Well done and thank you to all the children and staff involved!

A reminder that we would once again very much like for you to see first-hand what a typical morning in school entails and familiarise yourselves some of the children's learning experiences. Therefore, we will be holding our annual Open Mornings this term on Wednesday 29 January and Tuesday 4 February between 9a.m. and 11a.m. These mornings will be an opportunity for you to hear from the Senior Leadership Team and Chair of Governors as we share with you the main priorities for the school, including our long-term strategic plan, and discuss the main features of our School Improvement Plan. Next week on Thursday 16th January we will be holding the first of this year's coffee mornings, an informal opportunity for you to come into school and meet Christina Ekperigin our Family Liaison Officer and catch up over a cup of coffee. The session will be held in the Main Hall after drop off with all who attend asked to use the main entrance and sign in at the school office. We look forward to seeing you there.

In order to ensure that all children are dismissed safely at the end of the day a reminder please that at pick up time all parents and carers of Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 children who are not waiting to collect a child from Key Stage 2 should exit the playground as soon as their child has been collected. Key Stage 2 parents should wait for their children on the playground in front of the Adventure Playground away from the school buildings and behind the red line. KS2 Classes will be brought across the playground and dismissed from this point. Thank you for your co-operation with this.

Buster's Book Club 2020

Buster's Book Club will return next week as some of the participating schools only returned to school on Wednesday or Thursday of this week.

Buster's Book Club is a fun incentive to primary aged children to get into a book and enjoy reading at home. It is organised by Inspire Schools, the charity arm of the Kent Messenger Group which includes the KM local newspapers, KMFM and KMTV.

Each child will come home from school with a Buster's bookmark attached to their reading record book - all you have to do is write down the day each week that your child has read the most: a school, personal or library reading book, magazine, comic, website - anything that they have enjoyed reading, either to you or on their own.

The bookmark states that this should only be a Wednesday, but we understand that this is not practical or fair for a lot of families, so please, just use the day which the child has read the most - just have the bookmark completed by Wednesday so the totals can be added up on Thursday morning.

The children can earn badges (bronze, silver and gold). These are awarded for outstanding effort, improvement and achievement.

The coffee morning will be held in the main hall between 09:00 and 09:45.


Everyone is welcome as it will be a chance to find out more about the FLO and Inclusions roles in an informal way over a chat and a drink.


Urgent messages can also be sent via SMS. Please make sure we have an up-to-date mobile telephone number. We use Teachers to Parents SMS.


